

New York District Chapter of the Year 2018

Starting in 2018, our CHoY participants will rely on a few different programs already in place to accumulate points toward the District CHoY.

First and foremost, credits will be given towards chasing the Traveling Plaque with five or more Members. Credits will also be awarded for GWRRA registered Instructors who teach seminars in their home Chapter as well as at other Chapters' and District events.

- *10 Points shall be awarded to any New York Chapter that successfully captures the Traveling Plaque with five or more members;*
- *4 Points shall be awarded to any New York Chapter (5 or more members) that travels to another Chapter that is holding the Traveling Plaque, but is unsuccessful at capturing the plaque;*
- *2 Points shall be awarded to a Chapter whose Instructor presents one or more seminars at a District or another Chapter's event;*
- *1 Point shall be awarded to any Chapter whose Instructor presents one or more seminars to his/her own Chapter;*
- *3 Points shall be awarded to any Chapter hosting an approved District Event;*
- *2 Points shall be awarded to any Chapter having 5 or more members participating in an approved NY District Event.*

Traveling Plaque Points

A completed D4C submittal form or equivalent, including a photo showing all Chapter Participants and their names and the event name and date, will be necessary to substantiate points awarded. (Members' expiration dates will be verified.)

Seminars

To receive points for Seminars taught during the year, Instructors must submit a PDF copy of the roster or a group class photo.

Hosting a District Event

To receive points for hosting a District event, the event must be listed on the Hosting Chapter's Schedule or Calendar.

Submittals

The Chapter of the Year packages must be submitted between January 1st and February 15th of the following year.

CHoY Winner

A Chapter cannot be awarded Chapter of the Year for two consecutive years.

CHoY Reward

The most deserving Chapter will be selected as Chapter of the Year based on the points accumulated. Two Runners-Up will also be selected. Recognition will be at the NY District Administration's discretion.
